



## THE FACES OF CHRONIC FATIGUE SYNDROME NATIONAL TRAVELING PHOTO EXHIBIT BOILERPLATE

*The Faces of Chronic Fatigue Syndrome (CFS)* is a traveling photo exhibit that is part of a national health education initiative sponsored by the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention and the CFIDS Association of America. It features huge full-color portraits, taken by famous fashion and celebrity photographer George Lange, of 8 CFS patients and 2 CFS experts, including quotes from each person about their experiences with the illness. Together, the 10 banners and first-person accounts tell a compelling story about CFS and how it affects lives. The exhibit also includes takeaway brochures with important information about symptoms, diagnosis and treatment. *The Faces of Chronic Fatigue Syndrome* is part of the first nationwide education and awareness campaign for CFS in the United States.
